

INVITATION

We invite the skiracers that are registered in one of the lowland nations (GBR, BEL, NED, and LUX) to compete at the 2nd Indoor Lowland Championships held at SnowWorld Landgraaf in the Netherlands. This event is organized by the lowland nations with the idea to bring the Lowland nations close together.

Entry Criteria/Invitation:

Each race is open to racers registered with their respective home nation meeting the age group categories (U10, U12, U14, U16, U18, U21, SEN and MAS. Each Nation has a specific quota (GBR, NED and BEL will have a quota of 100 (60 \pm 5 male and 40 \pm 5 female) Lux will have a quota of 30.

Training possibility on Thursday and Friday:

There will be possibilities to train on Thursday and Friday. make sure you bring your own slalom poles. Reservations must be made directly to SnowWorld: skiteams@snowworld.com 2 SL lanes available. Training blocks on Thursday and friday: 17:00 19:00 7:00-9:00 9:30: 11:30 12:00-14:00 14:30-16:30 19:30 - 21:30

Costs: Slope entry on Thursday and Friday is included in the 'SnowWorld package deal' If you need slope entry separately on Thursday and Friday the cost will be 25,- euro per day per person available at the SnowWorld ticket office.

Race entry information:

The entry fee for this event is €25 per raceday (25,- euro = race fee and slope entry). The payment must be made per team/club after the captains meeting on Friday evening. Each Nation has to send their entries at least at 1st of September to: sportsecretariaat@wintersport.nl

If a nation has remaining quota after the 1st of September; the remaining quota will go to the nations that have a full quota. These remaining quota's entries must be made before September 14th. After September 14th event is closed for all Nations.

Race information:

The races will be slalom format. The U10 and U12 are racing with stubbies and the remaining age groups with 27 mm poles.

Prize Giving Ceremony

- Saturday: There will be a price giving ceremony after the race on Saturday for the **SnowWorld Cup** (day result for all categories). This race also counts for the Nations Cup!
- Sunday : Day result for all categories for the **Indoor Lowlands Championship** Nations Cup: the nation that receives the most points during the event wins the Nations Cup.

Nations Cup

The top 5 of the categories U10,U12,U14,U16,U18,U21 and 21+ on Saturday and Sunday will receive points for the nation's cup.

The nation that collects the most points during these 2 race days and/or team event receives the nation's cup. Points per category:

1st 15 points - 2nd 9 points - 3rd 5 points - 4th 3 points - 5th 1 point

Points during Parallel nation team event: 1^{st team} 60 points - 2^{nd team} 40 points - 3^{rd team} 30 points

Rules:

- The Race will be run in accordance with FIS rules. For issues not covered by the FIS the Jury will decide.
- During inspection racers need to wear or carry their bib so that it is visible. This is to show that you are entitled to be in the course area.
- Inspection on foot by racers is not permissible
- Helmets must been worn by racers at all times whilst on the slope.
- The U10 / U12 course will be run using stubbies.
